<u>Item 1 – Welcome from Chair</u>

NB welcomed all to the meeting

Item 2 - Approval of minutes from the previous meeting

<u>Item 3 – Matters Arising</u>

ZS raised that two ideas on the student say hub had passed 25 likes in the space between the agenda being sent out and the meeting

<u>Item 5 – Motions Debate</u>

ES introduced her motion - Refreshments in the Trinity Building

NB highlighted the link between the lack of engagement from certain student groups and a corresponding lack of facilities

Council voted to approve the motion unanimously

Item 6 – AOB

LB raised his Student Say vote on having a Pride Flag outside the University entrance which he put up on Monday and was currently on roughly 50 upvotes and 10 downvotes

NB explained that the motion would be going to the next council, but this meeting of council could encourage CI to start exploring the possibilities and set the ball rolling

CI raised that there had been some concerns with the wording of the motion on the student say hub

LB expressed regret that he had insinuated that the University may not be LGBT* friendly NB asked for an indicative vote to see if they wanted CI to pursue the Pride Flag policy Council voted unanimously in favour
