#### Item 3: LTSU Volunteering Policy

C. Isherwood introduces LTSU's new volunteering policy. Council approve the policy and suggest that it is reviewed every year.

#### Item 4: I Heart Consent Campaign

M. Haugh introduces a proposed draft policy, regarding sexual consent, harassment and assault. **Council approve the policy.** 

Action: M. Haugh to meet with C. Isherwood and M. Webber to discuss changes to the Students' Union's bye-law regarding disciplinary matters.

M. Haugh proposes amendments to the joint policy from the Students' Union and the University named 'Zero Tolerance to Sexual Harrassment'

#### Council approve the following changes:

1. Policy title and wording to refer to both sexual harassment and assault as separate breaches.

- 2. Wording of policy to be more gender neutral.
- 3. The policy's definition of harassment to be strengthened.
- 4. Include updated statistics.
- 5. Policy to include signposting to where students can access guidance on sexual harassment and assault.
- 6. URL to be added of where it is kept on the Students' Union website.
- 7. Policy should be highlighted to all staff, as well as signposting and any action around the policy (e.g. related campaigns)
- 8. Policy requires stronger publicity across every area of campus (e.g. framed copy in every building)
- 9. Policy should be available in all places listed in the policy.
- 10. Wording from 'shall' to change to 'will'.
- 11. Historic wording regarding LTSU contracted staff to be updated.

# Action: M. Haugh/O. Sharp to circulate edited copy of policy around to all Council members prior to it being presented at the University's committee on Friday.
