Leeds Trinity Students' Union notes:

- A1. Sustainability is an issue that reaches all students. We also have a lot of research that shows how changes and attitudes that are made at University will affect people in the long-term.
- A2. This is a result of specific primary research from Green Impact.

Leeds Trinity Students' Union believes:

- B1. The Union should be setting a high standard when it comes to being sustainable.
- B2. That by practically supporting students' in developing sustainability on campus, we will in turn be supporting students' to reach their fullest potential.
- B3. That students should feel confident and reassured that the Union are doing everything they can to combat unnecessary waste.
- B4. That students should be confident that the Union can provide sufficient support in helping all students and staff becoming more sustainable individuals and teams.

Leeds Trinity Students' Union resolves:

- C1. The Union will campaign for an increased presence of recycling bins around campus, specifically for the Canteen, Starbucks and in lecture rooms.
- C2. The Union will campaign for a minimum standard of having a sign in each lecture room or main communal space to make people aware of the closest general waste bin and recycling bin.
- C.3. The Union will encourage members of council and students to participate in behaviour change projects and campaigns to involve all students.
- C.4. The Union will remain aware and up-to-date with its own sustainable practices and consciously continue to develop its awareness and support staff development within sustainable practices in the workplace.
- C.5. The Union will continuously strive for at least a 'Good' accreditation from Green Impact.

- D.3. This policy will be the responsibility of both the Sustainability officer and the President.
