Union Notes

- 1. There are currently no water coolers in the Trinity Building
- 2. There are no hot drink facilities in the Trinity Building
- 3. This means that when students are given breaks during teaching time, they are forced to run over to another building just to get a drink
- 4. Water Coolers encourage students to bring their own water bottles and thus help to reduce the volume of single-use plastics being used by students

Union Believes

- 1. Students who are often taught in the Trinity building should have access to the same facilities as students who work on other parts of campus
- 2. Having to run to other parts of campus means that a student cannot actually use their break to relax
- 3. The university should be doing all it can to discourage single-use plastics

Union Resolves
